SUBJECT: Crew Rest Unit Bunk Kits

NATURE OF THE GRIEVANCE:

The Union claims that Air Canada violated articles 3, 13, L18, L22, L28, all relevant provisions of the Collective Agreement, and any other relevant legislation, act, or statute by failing to provide crew rest unit bunk kits as specified in the Collective Agreement.

SETTLEMENT REQUESTED:

- 1) Air Canada abide by the Collective Agreement;
- 2) Cease and desist all identified violations;
- 3) A declaration that Air Canada has violated the Collective Agreement by failing to provide crew rest unit bunk kits as specified in the Collective Agreement;
- 4) Make all affected employees whole;
- 5) Damages be paid to the Union;
- 6) Provide for any other redress dee med appropriate.

We request a hearing within the contractual time limits and that the Company provide all documentation relied upon in this matter.
