SUBJECT: LOU 38 (Profit Share Payments for Those Who Resign)

#### **NATURE OF THE GRIEVANCE:**

The Union claims that Air Canada violated the Collective Agreement. Specifically, Air Canada has unreasonably denied profit share payments to members who have resigned.

We submit this grievance under articles/clauses 3, L38, all other pertinent sections of the Collective Agreement, and any other relevant legislation, act, or statute.

#### **SETTLEMENT REQUESTED:**

### We request that,

- 1. Air Canada abide by the Collective Agreement;
- 2. Air Canada cease and desist the violation;
- 3. Pay the required profit share to employees who have resigned
- 4. Make all affected employees whole;
- 5. Pay damages to the Union;
- 6. Provide for any other redress deemed appropriate.

We request a hearing within the contractual time limits and that the Company provide all documentation relied upon in this matter.
