SUBJECT: Failure to Consult - Onboard Crew Rest - New Aircraft - B737 (Article 23.03.02)

DEPARTMENT: Mr. Giuseppe Morello, Director, Air Canada Labour Relations - IFS

NATURE OF THE GRIEVANCE:

The Union claims that Air Canada violated the Collective Agreement and is filing a policy grievance. Specifically, Air Canada violated articles 2.01, 3, 23.03.02 and all relevant provisions of the Collective Agreement, and any other relevant legislation, act, or statute, by not adequately consulting with the Union when establishing crew rest seats on the newly implemented B737 aircraft.

SETTLEMENT REQUESTED:

- 1. Air Canada abide by the Collective Agreement;
- 2. A declaration that Air Canada has violated the Collective Agreement by failing to consult with the Union when establishing crew rest seats on the B737;
- 3. Cease and desist all identified violations;
- 4. Make all affected employees whole;
- 5. Damages be paid to the Union;
- 6. Provide for any other redress deemed appropriate.

We request a hearing within the contractual time limits and that the Company provide all documentation relied upon in this matter.
