GRIEVANCE FORM

GRIEVANCE NUMBER: CHQ-19-18 (POLICY)

SUBJECT: Article 2.04.02.01 (Air Canada rouge Premium Seats)

DEPARTMENT: Mr. Giuseppe Morello, Director, Air Canada Labour Relations – IFS

NATURE OF THE GRIEVANCE:

I/We, the undersigned claims that Air Canada violated the Collective Agreement, including articles 2.04.02.01, 3, 21, all relevant provisions of the Collective Agreement, and any other relevant legislation, act, or statute.

Specifically, the forward cabin of Air Canada rouge wide body aircraft include premium seats that are **wider** than those in the Air Canada Premium Economy cabin on Mainline wide body aircraft. Additionally, the forward cabin of Air Canada rouge narrow body aircraft include premium seats that are **wider** than those in the Air Canada Business Class cabin on Mainline narrow body aircraft.

SETTLEMENT REQUESTED:

1. Air Canada abide by the Collective Agreement;
2. A declaration that Air Canada has violated the Collective Agreement by including wider premium seats in the forward cabin of Air Canada rouge wide body aircraft than those included in the Air Canada Premium Economy cabin on Mainline wide body aircraft;
3. A declaration that Air Canada has also violated the Collective Agreement by including wider premium seats in the forward cabin of Air Canada rouge narrow body aircraft than those included in the Air Canada Business Class cabin on Mainline narrow body aircraft;
4. Cease and desist all identified violations;
5. Make all affected employees whole;
6. Provide for any other redress deemed appropriate.

The Union requests a hearing within the contractual time limits and that the Company provide all documentation relied upon in this matter.
