**NATURE OF THE GRIEVANCE:**

I/We, the undersigned, claim that Air Canada has violated Air Canada Collective Agreement. Specifically, Air Canada Crew scheduling department extended crew member's pairings and did not provide draft pay for their scheduled day off.

I/We submit this grievance under LOU 55, articles/ clauses L55.07, L55.14.12, L55.14.13 and any related articles, acts or statutes, and all other pertinent sections of the Air Canada Collective Agreement.

**SETTLEMENT REQUESTED:**

- 1) Air Canada rouge abide by the Air Canada Collective Agreement;
- 2) Air Canada pay the affected crew members the draft premium when a pairing is extended into scheduled days off;
- 3) Provide for any other remedy deemed appropriate by the Arbitrator;
- 4) Make the grievers whole.

**We request a hearing within the contractual time limits and that the Company provide all documentation relied upon in this matter.**
