GRIEVANCE NUMBER: CHQ-rouge-19-23 (POLICY)

SUBJECT: Unpaid Training – Rouge Annual Recurrent, Requalification and Initial Service Workbooks

DEPARTMENT: Mr. Giuseppe Morello, Director, Air Canada Labour Relations - IFS

NATURE OF THE GRIEVANCE:

The Union claims that Air Canada violated the Collective Agreement, including but not limited to Articles 3, 6.04, L55.03, L55.06.05 any and all other relevant provisions of the Collective Agreement, and any and all relevant statutes or legislation by requiring the mandatory completion of the Rouge Annual Recurrent, Requalification and Initial Service Workbooks by Cabin Personnel. Cabin Personnel are expected to have these workbooks completed prior to attending training and are therefore required to do this work on their own time, outside of regular (paid) training courses, and are being denied pay, contrary to the Collective Agreement.

SETTLEMENT REQUESTED:

1. Cease and desist from requiring the mandatory completion of the Rouge Annual Recurrent, Requalification, Initial Service Workbooks and any future workbook for which there is no pay;
2. Ensure that required completion of training materials be incorporated into training programs for which there is pay;
3. Make all affected employees whole;
4. Provide for any other remedy deemed appropriate.

We request a hearing within the contractual time limits and that the Company provide all documentation relied upon in this matter.
