



GRIEVANCE NUMBER: CHQ-19-55 (POLICY)
SUBJECT: B3.02, Pairing Changes Prior to Bid Deadline

NATURE OF THE GRIEVANCE:

The Union claims that Air Canada violated the Collective Agreement by failing to publish changes to pairings prior to the bid deadline up to one (1) day in excess of the longest cycle at that Base.

We submit this grievance under articles/clauses 3, 13, B3.02, all other pertinent sections of the Collective Agreement, and any other relevant legislation, act, or statute.

SETTLEMENT REQUESTED:

1. Air Canada abide by the Collective Agreement;
2. Air Canada cease and desist the violation;
3. Make all affected employees whole;
4. Pay damages to the Union;
5. Provide for any other redress deemed appropriate.

We request a hearing within the contractual time limits and that the Company provide all documentation relied upon in this matter.
