Release 21-1 of PBS has been installed. Along with a couple of fixes, there are a few changes/enhancements to PBS which will be reviewed in this bulletin.



As with any update to PBS, you should:

# Clear your browser's cache and web data

The "Old" User Interface remains in effect. Once the end of support for this interface has been determined, you will be advised of the end date along with a pre-determined "sunset" period of no less than three (3) months.

Remember that if you access PBS using the Direct/Alternate access link (bypassing the portal) then continue to use the following:



### Category Seniority on Info Tab (Mainline Only):

Your relative seniority will now be displayed on the Info Tab. The first number is your category ranking at your base and the second number is the total number of crew members at your base within the same category. These numbers are followed by your seniority percentage within your category.

In the example below, the crew member is in the FA category. They rank 37<sup>th</sup> out of 316 FAs at their base. Their seniority percentage is 11.7%.






If you are dual classified and have the ability to bid as both SD and FA, your category seniority will only be available in the SD category.


If you are an FA, the total number of FAs at your base will <u>not</u> include any dual classified SD who may be flown as an FA.

### Allowances added to printed list of pairings:

In the Pairings Tab, you can print lists of either all pairings or of any current filtered pairings by clicking on the printer icon at the top of the page.



The printed lists now include the Allowance amount (when selected) as shown below:




#### Corrected syntax for error messages:

Error messages have been corrected to align with the new pairing group syntax. Bid submission errors will now include the reference to Pairing Bid Group and/or Reserve Bid Group instead of the old Start Pairings or Start Reserve.

### Max Above feature automatically combined with ESNBG:

The Max Above feature available under the Award Reserve bid group is now automatically combined with Else Start Next Bid Group (ESNBG). There is no longer the need to manually check off the ESNBG option listed under the Max Above feature as it is no longer displayed.



As soon as the Max Above feature is opened, the bid line in progress will show the ESNBG tag:

Award Reserve Max Above 0 Else Start Next Bid Group

Once the desired Max Above value is entered and Apply is clicked on, the bid line will be numbered and show as follows:

23 Award Reserve Max Above 5 Else Start Next Bid Group



There are no changes to the PBS processing logic.

### Addition to the allocation process of UDOs (Rouge Only):

There is a new step to the allocation process of UDOs based on the time that a pairing ends on the day prior to the possible UDO assignment. PBS will not award a UDO on the day following a pairing that is scheduled to end at or after 22:30. All other UDO awarding processes will remain the same.

#### Example:

- · Pairing T1234 has been awarded and ends at 22:35 on October 17th. The pairings award is now complete.
- The request is for Prefer Off October 18, 2020, October 19, 2020 in the first bid line, but PBS will not assign a UDO on October 18th, however one may be awarded on October 19th (if possible).

### Example:

- · Pairing T1456 has been awarded and ends at 22:29 on October 12th. The pairings award is now complete.
- · The request is for Prefer Off October 13, 2020, October 14, 2020, October 11, 2020 in the first bid line, PBS may assign a UDO on October 11th, another on October 13th and one may be awarded on October 14th (if possible).
