**All crew members who were originally due for REC in January 2022 will be considered as MUST GO.**

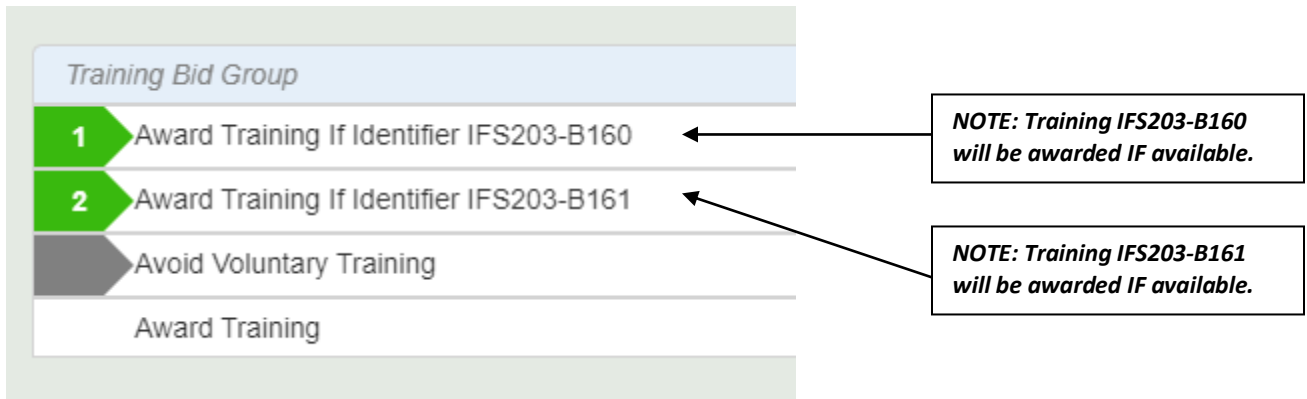
Those crew members who were originally due for REC in either November or December 2021 and received an extension, will be considered as MAY GO for REC in January 2022. Keep in mind that if there are more training seats in January for MAY GO members than those who bid for it, the seats will be filled in reverse order of seniority. It is highly recommended to have a training bid in place even if you are a MAY GO. See bidding examples 4 & 5 below.

***A REMINDER TO CREWMEMBERS:*** *If you just bid training by Type, your Training will be awarded at that line. Please see examples below.*

### Bidding Example 1:

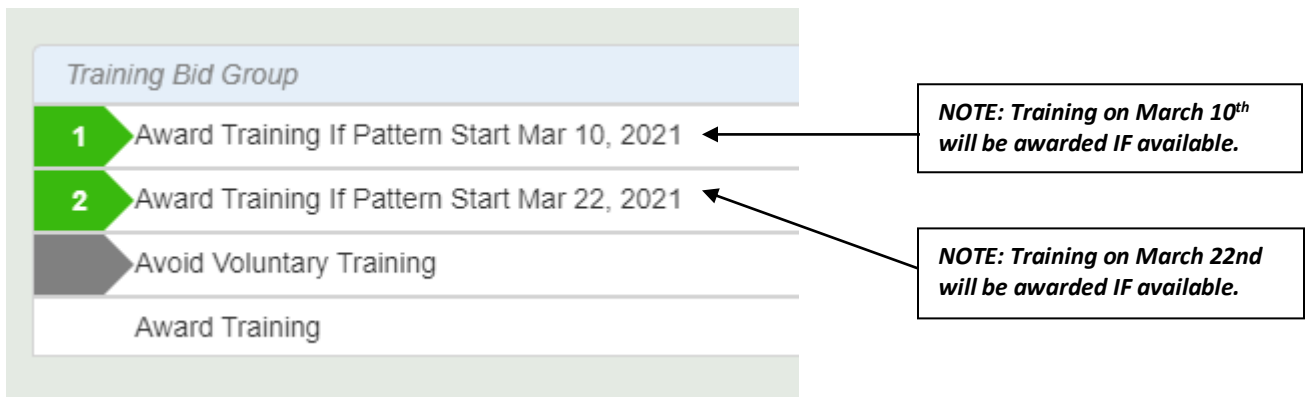
***NOTE:*** *In this example, even though you are specific in bid line 2, your Recurrent will be awarded at bid line 1 as no date or Identifier is indicated at this higher bid line. If you wish to bid for a certain date or session (Identifier) as in bid line 2, then this bid line should be placed higher in your bid.*

**Bidding Example 2:** This crewmember bids using specific Identifier(s)



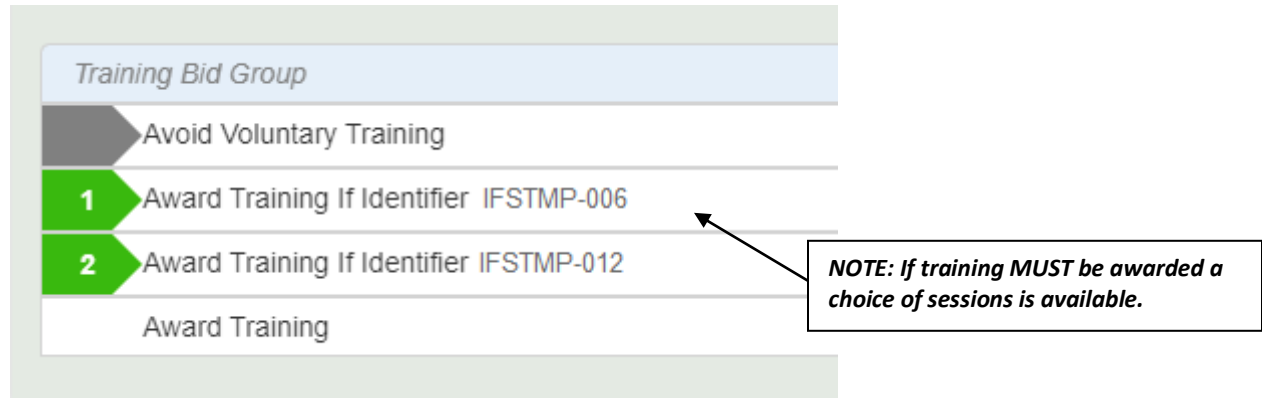
**NOTE:** In this example, since you were specific with your requests (1: IFS203-B160, 2: IFS203-B161) this is the order that your Recurrent would be awarded. In this example, if neither is available, PBS would award Recurrent on any date. It is therefore recommended to bid multiple bid lines.

**Bidding Example 3:** This crewmember bids using a specific date(s)



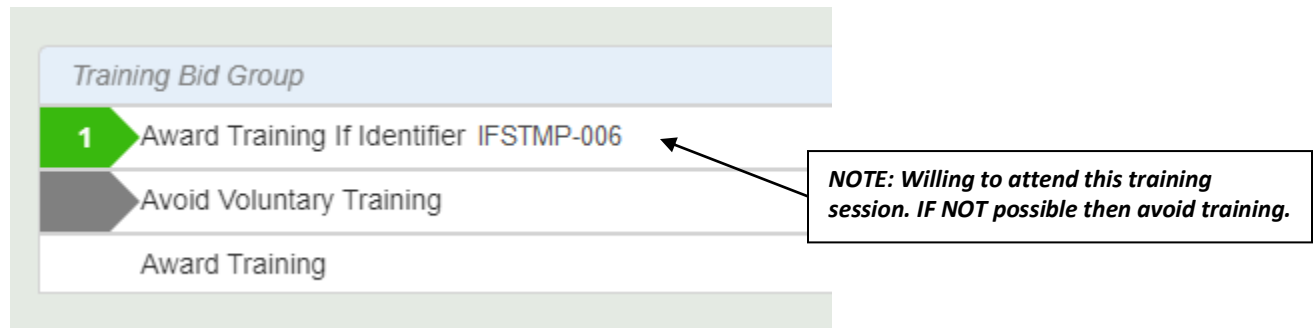
**NOTE:** In this example, since you were specific with your requests (1: Pattern Start March 10, 2: March 22) this is the order that your Recurrent would be awarded. In this example, if neither is available, PBS would award Recurrent on any date. It is therefore recommended to bid multiple bid lines.

**Bidding Example 4:** To avoid training (if possible)



**NOTE:** In this example, I tried to avoid training by leaving the embedded **Avoid Voluntary Training** at the top of my bid. If I cannot avoid the training and must attend, a choice of sessions is listed. It is therefore recommended to bid multiple bid lines.

**Bidding Example 5:** This crewmember bids using specific Identifier(s). If not awarded, then avoid training (if possible)



**NOTE:** In this example, I would like to attend a specific session as specified on bid line 1. If the session is full, I will try to avoid training by leaving the embedded **Avoid Voluntary Training** after bid line 1. If I cannot avoid the training and must attend, PBS would award training on any date.
