

# PBS: Release 18-3 Install

Release 18-3 of PBS was installed on the Production Servers late last week. Along with a couple of fixes, there are a few changes to how PBS looks which will be reviewed in this bulletin. In addition to bulletins, the PBS Committee will begin releasing short videos on various topics related to PBS. We hope that these, along with the bulletins, assist you in using the New Interface.

## In this bulletin:

- Set Condition No Same Day Pairings (Else Start Next Bid Group) – ACA + RGA
- New UI: Modify bid lines containing dates from a previous bid period – ACA + RGA
- New UI: Pairings Tab – ACA + RGA
- PBS Information Videos – ACA + RGA

# PBS: Release 18-3 Install

## New UI: Pairings Tab:

With PBS Release 18-3, you may now choose to see the dates that the pairing operates. When the “Dates” option is selected under Show/Hide Columns, PBS will highlight the dates with a grey circle. [1].

One other change to the Show/Hide Column options is that “Length” [3] will now turn on/off the pairing length (in days) indicator [4].

# PBS: Release 18-3 Install

When performing a pairing filter (search) with the Departing On parameter (Date, Date Range, Day of Week), PBS will highlight the specified dates for the filtered pairings in green [5].
