

PBS: 22-5 Update

PBS Release 22-5 has been installed. Although no new features or enhancements are included in this update, there are several bug fixes. Installing the most up-to-date release available helps ensure system stability.



As of Release 21-3, PBS will compare the version number of the information stored in certain browser's caches to that of the information stored on the server. If the versions differ, the contents of the browser cache will be cleared to maintain compatibility between server and browser for each session. **This may result in the loss of saved bids but does not impact submitted bids.** A pop-up will inform you if the cache will be cleared. You must click "OK" to proceed.

If you do not receive a pop-up message, you may need to manually clear your cache to update the version of PBS displayed in your browser.

We highly recommend bidding in the WebApp (New UI) whenever possible.

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Warning

***If Not + Depart On* bug**

A bug has been discovered when using *If Not + Depart On* (*Dates List, Dates Range, Days of Week List*) together on the same bid line. Navblue has acknowledged the discrepancy and has created a fix which will be available in a future release.

When using *If Not + Depart On* together on the same bid line, PBS may automatically change the *If Not* to *If* when the bid line is edited for any purpose.

Until the new release containing the fix has been installed, it is important to review any bid line(s) containing *If Not + Depart On* to ensure that the *If Not* remains and has not been changed to *If* before submitting your bid.

NAVBLUE N-PBS requires JavaScript, pop-up windows and cookies enabled in all browsers. See browser documentation for more details.

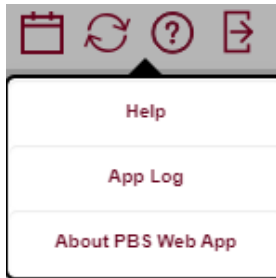

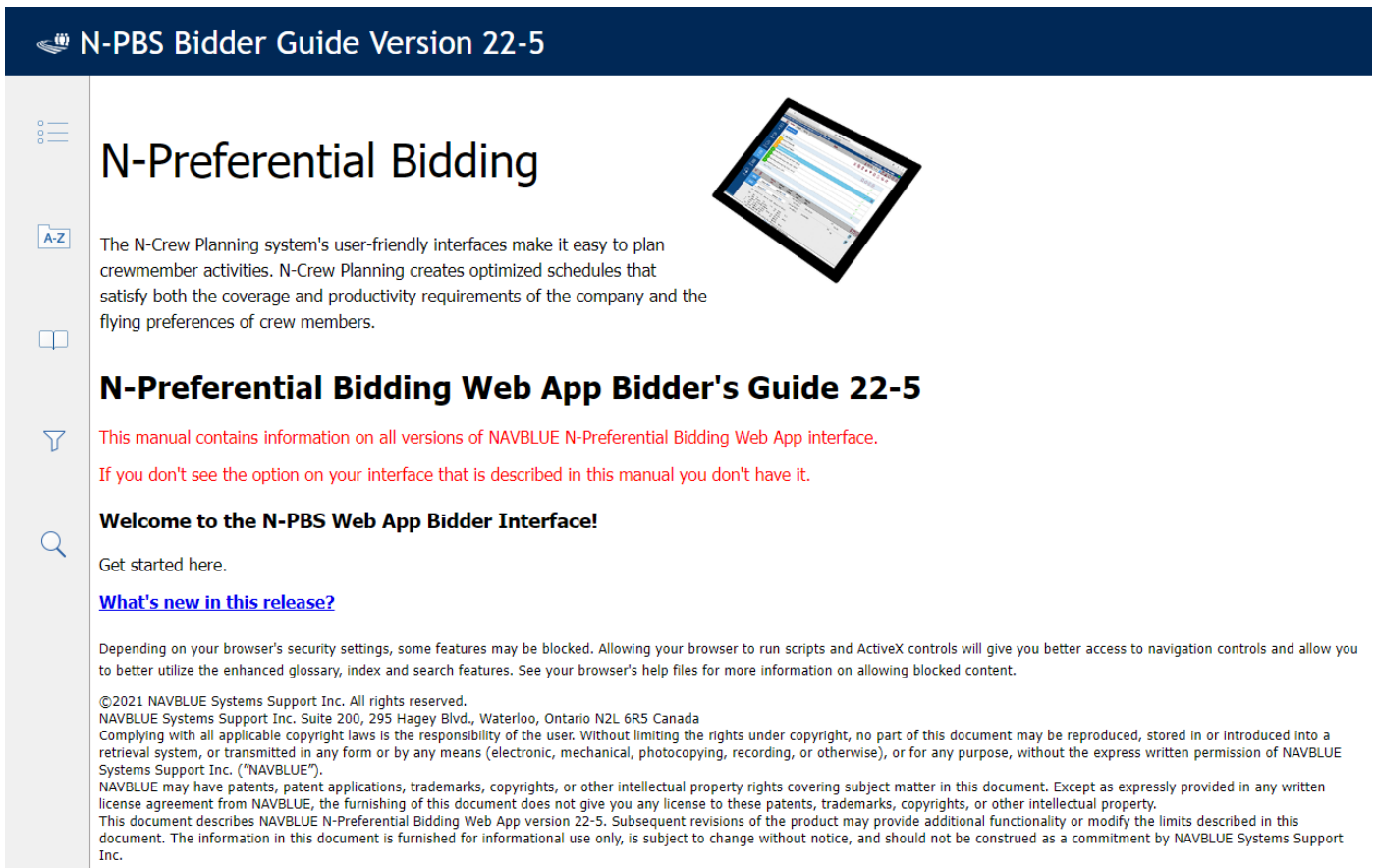
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PBS Help function

The Help function  located at the top right of all pages will display the following menu when clicked:

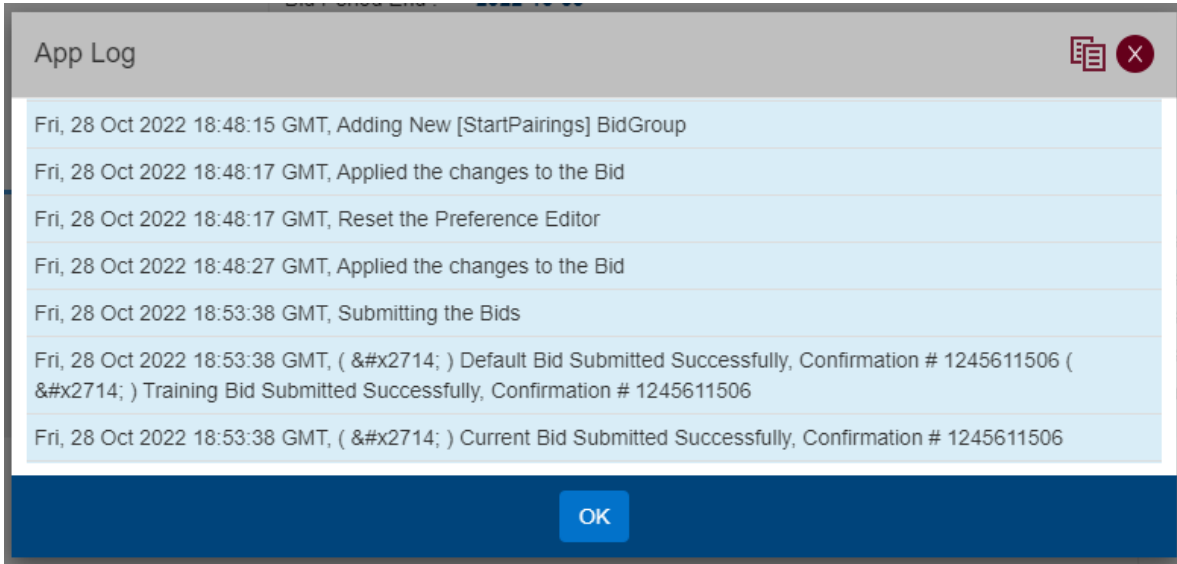

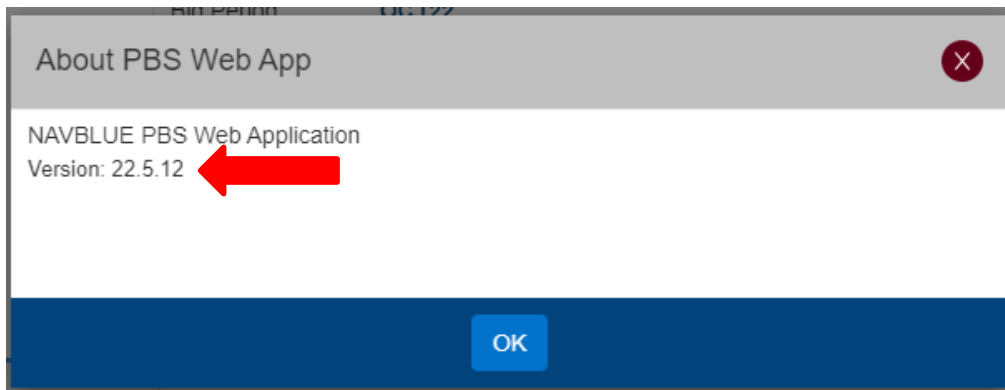

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App Log – All actions done by and in the New UI are recorded here. Everything from initial download, synchronization, caching and other automated actions as well as every action you do will be seen here. You will have to scroll down to see all the information. This information is kept until the cache is cleared or a new period is loaded by administration.



About PBS Web App – This will display the version of PBS you have loaded. With this update you should see the following:



If you have an older version of the PBS Web App displayed, you will need to logout of PBS and clear your browser's cache.

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PBS Bidder's Guide and Bulletins

The PBS Bidder's Guide is an abbreviated tool and reference to help you bid using the Air Canada version of Navblue's Preferential Bidding System. It provides information on most preferences available to you as well the processing logic used by PBS to create the awards. Although the Guide dates from 2015 and all screenshots depict the Old UI, the vast majority of information remains applicable.

PBS Bulletins have been issued alongside updates to the system since the WebApp New UI was introduced in 2017. Any new features, enhancements and processing changes which are not contained in the Bidder's Guide have been included in the bulletins. A revised Side-by-Side of the Old UI vs New UI was issued in 2021 and depicts screenshots of both UIs with updated information. This bulletin may be of particular use to members switching to the New UI as well as for New Hires learning the system for the first months. Further PBS bulletins have been issued highlighting specific features such as Set Conditions, Offline Mode, Dual Classification and general bidding reminders.
